

Cattle Breed and Small Ruminant Improvement Project (CBSRIP)

Cattle Breed and Small Ruminant Improvement Programme (CBSRIP) has been launched by the Fisheries and Animal Resources Development Department (F&ARD) in collaboration with J.K Trust Gram Vikas Yojana through establishment of 310 “Integrated Livestock Development (ILD) Centres under RKVY in 15 districts of our state i.e Balasore, Bargarh, Bhadrak, Boudh, Cuttack, Ganjam, Koraput, Kalahandi, Keonjhar, Malkangiri, Mayurbhanj, Nowrangapur, Nuapada, Rayagada and Sundergarh.

Under this programme each of the ILD Center will be manned by a trained Artificial Insemination (AI) worker called “Gopal” who primarily provides AI along with other veterinary services like castration, first aids, Vaccinations , deworming etc. at door steps of the farmers. Besides, farmers will be made aware of various State Govt. Sponsored Animal welfare Schemes under implementation in the State through extension programme. The project envisages production of progenies of high genetic merit along with enhancement of milk production of the State thereby assuring Dairy based livelihood support to the livestock owners of the State.
